

New Membership Categories and Fees (2021)

Regular Membership: The current annual membership fee is \$1,128.00 per year, billed monthly. At the option of the member, this fee may be paid annually, semi-annually, or quarterly. There is a one-time initiation fee of \$1,128.00 due at the time the application is submitted.

Military Membership: The current annual membership fee is \$1,128.00 per year, billed monthly. At the option of the member, this fee may be paid annually, semi-annually, or quarterly. There is a one-time initiation fee of \$1,128.00 that is deferred for three years. To qualify for a Military Membership, you must be on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States, stationed on the Monterey Peninsula, and at least 21 years of age.

Non-Resident Membership: The current annual membership fee is \$601.00 per year, billed monthly. At the option of the member, this fee may be paid annually, semi-annually, or quarterly. There is a one-time initiation fee of \$1,128.00 due at the time the application is submitted. To qualify for this membership category, you must be at least 21 years of age and normally reside further than 60 statute miles in a direct line from the Clubhouse of the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club.

Intermediate Membership: The current annual membership is \$330.00 per year, billed monthly. At the option of the member, this fee may be paid annually, semi-annually, or quarterly. There is not an initiation fee associated with this membership category. To qualify you must be at least 21 years of age and less than 30 years of age.

All members are charged an additional \$5.00 per month piling fee to ensure there are funds available when pilings (the posts which hold up the club) need to be replaced.
