NOTICE OF RACE

A & B Fleet Perpetual Trophies

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. The Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the PHRF Spring, Summer and Fall Series. The MPYC invites club members to enter under the conditions of this Notice of Race (NOR).
- 1.2. The OA reserves the right to amend this Notice of Race. The OA will post amendments at the website www.MPYC.org

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 including US Sailing prescriptions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats owned by MPYC members.
- 3.2. Entries shall be made online, using the MPYC Regatta Network portal at [MPYC Race Registration Packet](#)

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fees are specified in the MPYC Regatta Network race registration portal.

5. BOATS

- 5.1. The regatta will be sailed in boats with valid PHRF ratings issued by the Monterey Bay PHRF Committee.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. The PHRF Spring, Summer & Fall Series schedule will be published in the Race Calendar available at www.MPYC.org.
- 6.2. The PHRF Spring II race will also serve as the Lefler Regatta, while the MPYC Fall II race will coincide with the John Duncan Memorial Regatta. See separate Notices of Race for these regattas.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The 2019 Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club Sailing Instructions will apply. Additional sailing instructions, if required will be published at www.MPYC.org.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. Racing will occur in southern Monterey Bay, near Monterey, CA.
- 8.2. The starting area will be in the vicinity of the MPYC Committee Boat.

9. **COURSES**

9.1. The courses are described at www.MPYC.org.

10. **SCORING**

- 10.1. Scoring of all MPYC races will be in accordance with the 2019 MPYC Sailing Instructions.
- 10.2. As per the MPYC Racing Calendar, the Spring/Summer/Fall PHRF series shall each comprise of a maximum of five races of which one will be a long-distance race (see 6.2 above).
- 10.3. The Spring/Summer/Fall PHRF series fleet winners and the overall PHRF Championship per fleet shall be awarded based on the total number of places scored during each series and the overall season.

11. **PRIZES**

11.1. The Race Chair Chairman, in consultation with the MPYC Flag Officers and the Fleet Captains, will determine trophies for the PHRF Spring, Summer & Fall Series. Generally, trophies are awarded for first, second and third place finishers in each class for each series; except for a class with less than 5 entries may be awarded trophies for only first or only first and second place finishers at the discretion of the Race Chairperson.

12. **DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY**

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
