NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

1.2 Racing Rule 40 is changed as follows: Replace the entire Rule with, "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This rule applies at all times while afloat. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. Flag Y need not be displayed."

1.3 Standard and Radial rigs shall have separate starts and be scored separately. Each fleet shall include all Masters age divisions using that rig (ILCA-NA "Rig-swapping" rule turned off).

1.4 The organizing authority is the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club.

2 Eligibility and Entry

Competitors who are members of the International Laser Class Association and who have reached the age indicated in the categories below by regatta start date are eligible to compete. Competitors who are not members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association, may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority www.laser.org.

2.1 Masters Categories:

- Apprentice – 35-44 years of age
- Master – 45-54 years of age
- Grand Master – 55-64 years of age

- Great Grand Master – 65+ years of age

You must achieve the proper age by regatta start date.

2.2 Competitors will be required to agree to a waiver of liability as a condition of eligibility. This waiver must be completed either during online registration or at the event check-in.

3 Inspection and Measurement

Please ensure your sail numbers are applied in accordance with ILCA class rules. Sails may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Note that numbers and letters drawn on the sail with permanent ink pens are not legal. Refer to

4 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

7 Fees

7.1 Required Fees

The entry fee is \$180 (\$170 US Sailing Assn. Members) if received by Friday, June 14th. After June 14 the fee will be \$200 (\$190 US Sailing Assn. Members).

7.2 Entries will not be accepted after 10 am on July 19, 2019.

7.3 The entry fee will include one dinner during the regatta. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased for \$30.00 each.

8 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration.

9 Courses & Racing Area

9.1 Courses will be standard ILCA-NA courses as described in the ILCA-NA Masters Regatta Guidelines.

9.2 The racing area will be north of the MPYC yacht club about a mile out to sea.

10 Scoring

10.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.

10.2 Nine races (three per day) are scheduled, a minimum of 3 races must be completed to constitute a regatta.

10.3 When 6 or more races are completed a sailor may discard their worst score.

10.4 NA Master handicap system will be in place. You add the following points to each race to find the overall series winner. - Apprentices - add 3 points - Masters - add 2 points - Grand Masters - add 1 point - Great Grand Masters - add 0 points The results are recalculated and the person with the lowest score wins, etc.
