1	RULES	THE RACING RULES OF SAILING 2017-2020- READ 'EM! FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS & REGULATIONS US COAST GUARD DIRECTIVES
2	NOTICES TO COMPETITORS	LOOK FOR NOTICES TO BE POSTED AT THE YC ON THE RACE BOARD: MARKS THAT ARE MISSING, STARTING LINE, TIME CHANGES
3	CHANGES TO THE SI'S	TIME CHANGES MUST BE POSTED BY 8PM THE DAY BEFORE THE RACE OTHER CHANGES 2 HOURS BEFORE THE FIRST RACE START "L" FLAG ON THE WATER- MUST BE FOR ALL. RECORD THIS!
4	SIGNALS MADE ASHORE	MPYC FLAG POLE- THIS MAY BE FOR A POSTPONEMENT OR WEATHER DELAY NO LONGER 60 MINUTES AFTER DROP, USE COMMON SENSE!

7	RACING AREAS	2019 MPYC COURSE SHEET SHOWS FIXED MARKS AND COURSES DO NOT FEEL THAT YOU NEED TO BE ARTISTIC AND DESIGN A "COURSE FROM HELL"

- DUNCAN'S WATCH: 3 IS MINIMUM; 4 IS BETTER
- WHALERS AND RIB: 2 PER BOAT
- ALL PILOTS NEED TO BEA MEMBER & QUALIFIED
- LOGISTICS: LUNCHES, BEVERAGES
- FLAGS ON BOATS: INSPECT EARLY- THEY MAY HAVE BEEN MOVED!

THE WEATHER

- LOOK AHEAD
- NOAA WEATHER
- WEATHERBUG
- SAILFLOW
- DRESS TO STAY OUT
- EVALUATE THE WEATHER ON BOATS COMPETING
 - SMALL BOATS ARE MORE VULNERABLE
 - LESS-EXPERIENCED SKIPPERS AND CREW
 - ASK FLEET CAPTAINS IF IN DOUBT

BOATS TO BE USED

- DUNCAN'S WATCH-CREW WITH 3-4
 - CHECK BATTERY AND FUEL
 - AIR FLAGS OUT
 - COURSE BOARD
 - INSPECT FLAGS ON BRIDGE AND IN CABIN
- HETTY GREEN AND RACER CHASER-CREW WITH 2
 - GREAT PLATFORMS FOR MARK SETTING
- RIB
 - GOOD FOR PIN SETTING AND SAFETY
 - LIMITED ROOM ON BOARD FOR MARKS OR CAMERAMAN

COURSE SELECTION

- WIND DIRECTION AND SPEED
- LENGTH
- NUMBER OF RACES
- SYNCHRONIZING FINISHES
- WHEN TO RESTRICT FINISH

ON THE WATER

- ANCHORING TO ESTABLISH START AND FINISH
- COURSE SELECTION
- START
 - FINAL WX CHECK, COURSE POSTED, 5-MINUTE SEQUENCE(RRS PART 3, RULE 26), OLLIE BOX, SILENCE EXCEPT FOR SAFETY!
 - INDIVIDUAL RECALL IS "X" AND HORN; GENERAL RECALL IS "FIRST SUBSTITUTE AND 2 HORNS
- RC DUTIES
 - TIMER, BACK-UP TIMER, SITE LINE, FLAGS & RECALL FLAGS, SCRIBE
- THE FINISH
 - FIRST PART OF BOAT "IN NORMAL POSITION"
 - HITTING THE FINISH MARK

CRISES AND WHOOPS!

- SHORTENING COURSE
- MISSING MARK-SI'S REQUIRE ABANDONMENT
- HORN LATE
- FLAG LATE
- WIND DIES- ABANDON OR SHORTEN COURSE?
- SIGNIFICANT WIND DIRECTION CHANGE
- RC DRIFTS/BREAKS ANCHOR
